Kubi Rama (South Africa) is Deputy CEO of GL. She has 25 years' experience working in non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and institutions of higher learning. In that time her main focus has been on media, communication, education, research, training and gender. Rama has

contributed to several Barometers as the author of the Education; Constitutional and Legal Rights; Sexual and Reproductive Health and Sexual Diversity chapters. Rama served as associate editor and author of the Sexual Diversity and Economic Justice chapters of this Barometer.

Sifisosami Dube (Zimbabwe) is the Head of Policy and Movement Building at Gender Links. She began her work at GL as the Gender Justice and Governance Manager before becoming the SADC
