Women's Voice and Leadership South Africa

Funded by Global Affairs Canada from August 2019 - July 2023, this fund:

- Managed 71 grants worth CAD\$ 2 194 386 plus an additional 30 for UKAID.
- Reached almost 90 000 people; 65% women and girls, 34% men and boys; 1% persons with disability; 1% gender nonconforming.
- Hosted 36 training sessions and events using a variety of methods.
- Led to 191 campaigns that influenced 16 laws, policies or mechanisms in relation to GBV; traditional authorities; LGBTIQ rights; HIV and AIDS and decriminalisation of sex work.
- Shared 98 stories of change on organisational growth and development, leadership, GBV, Economic Empowerment, Social Media, SRHR and Youth Empowerment shared at two Learning and Sharing Summits.







Fonds pour l'Afrique australe

The Voice and Choice Southern Africa Fund

is a challenge fund that responds to ideas presented by civil society to strengthen sexual and reproductive health and rights. GL is managing this fund as a partner of Amplify Change, a UK based fund to break the silence on SRHR. The GBP 1.5 million fund (2022 -2024:

- Comprises 9 Movement Building grants in seven countries: Eswatini; Madagascar; DRC; Malawi; South Africa; Tanzania(3) and Zimbabwe.
- 29 opportunity grants in South Africa, Lesotho and Zimbabwe.

The 38 organisations work on Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) work across 7 different themes: LGBTQIA+; Menstrual health; Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights: Comprehensive Sexual Education; Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights: Advocacy & Safe abortion; GBV, HIV and AIDS; Sex work.
