Air pollution and longer distances to travel for cooking fuel, water

11% of population have access to clean cooking fuels and technology

90% of population have access to electricity

85% of population have at least basic drinking water services

57% of population have access to basic sanitation

Mortality rate attributed to unsafe water, unsafe sanitation and lack of hygiene is **44 per 100,000** population

Increases in violence and vulnerability to violence

Increase in child marriage

Increase in transactional sex

Increased workload and burden of care

Water scarcity

Increase in SGV

80% of population is moderate or severe food insecure

15% of population under-nourished

63% women employed in agriculture sector compared to **34% men**

Food insecurity

Heat stress results in pregnancy complications - maternal and neonatal mortality

MMR 179 deaths per 100,000 live births

Neonatal MR 23 per 1,000 live births

36% pregnant women have anaemia
54% children ages 6-59 months with anaemia

Damage to infrastructure - roads, transport systems, clinics
