National Adaption Plan submitted to UNFCC **X**

Air pollution and longer distances to travel for cooking fuel and water

50% of population have access to clean cooking fuels and technology

86% of population have access to electricity

80% of population have at least basic drinking water services

65% of population have access to basic sanitation

Mortality rate attributed to unsafe water, unsafe sanitation and lack of hygiene is **47 per 100,000** population

Increases in violence and vulnerability to violence

Increase in child marriage

Increase in transactional sex

Increased workload and burden of care

59% of population is moderate or severe food insecure

18% of population under-nourished

10% women employed in agriculture sector compared to **17% men**

Food insecurity

Heat stress results in pregnancy complications - maternal and neonatal mortality

MMR 118 deaths per 100,000 live births

Neonatal MR 25 per 1,000 live births

30% pregnant women have anaemia
42% children (6-59 months) with anaemia

Damage to infrastructure - roads, transport systems, clinics

Reduced/diverted resources

Disruption of health care services

Increase in SGV
