Air pollution and longer distances to travel for cooking fuel and water

100% of population have access to clean cooking fuels and technology

100% of population have access to electricity

98% of population have access to clean drinking water

100% of population have access to basic sanitation

Mortality rate attributed to unsafe water, unsafe sanitation and lack of hygiene is **8 per 100,000** population

Increases in violence and vulnerability to violence

Increase in child marriage

Increase in transactional sex

Increased workload and burden of care

Water scarcity

Increase in SGV

Climate crisis

Food insecurity

Disruption of health care services

Maternal health

14% of population is moderate or severe food insecure

3% of population under-nourished

Heat stress results in pregnancy complications - maternal and neonatal mortality

MMR 42 deaths per 100,000 live births
Neonatal MR 9 per 1,000 live births

27% pregnant women have anaemia
31% children (6-59 months) with anaemia

Damage to infrastructure - roads, transport systems, clinics
