Initiated in 2023, SAASA seeks to expand safe abortion provision through coordination, advocacy, training and education, as well as policy and legislative reform. We view increased access to safe abortion provision as central to sexual reproductive health rights, and reproductive justice and find conservative patriarchal views prevent full bodily autonomy.
