Signed and ratified Paris Agreement in 2018

National Adaption Plan submitted to UNFCC



Longer distances to travel for cooking fuel and water

2% have access to clean cooking fuels and technology

38% have access to electricity

Increased workload and burden of care

Increase in SGBV

55% of population is moderate or severe food insecure

25% of population under-nourished

Food insecurity

67% women employed in agriculture sector compared to **64% men**

57% have access to clean drinking water

> 30% have access to basic sanitation

Heat stress results is pregnancy complications - maternal and neonatal mortality

MMR 524 deaths per 100,000 Neonatal MR 20 per 1,000

48% pregnant women have anaemia'

Increases in violence and vulnerability to violenće
